- Smith was born on a plantation in Northern Neck, Virginia.
- 2 Smith was sold to an owner in Heathsville, Virginia.
- 3 On May 6, 1838, Smith along with two of his enslaved friends, Zip and Lorenzo, made their plan to escape to Newcastle, Delaware.
- Smith met an abolitionist named Simpson in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.
- Simpson sent Smith to connect with David Ruggles in New York City, New York. Ruggles was a conductor along the Underground Railroad.
- Ruggles sent Smith onward to Hartford, Connecticut before Smith made his way to Springfield.
- Smith recieved an education in Springfield, Massachussets
- Smith got married and relocated to Norwich, CT
