*Conviction and Sentence of King Lanson--Telegraph

William Lanson, the former proprietor of the Liberia Hotel, and the rascal who has caused so much trouble in this city for the last few years, has been found guilty, convicted and sentenced to 6 months imprisonment in the County Jail, and to pay a fine of \$50.
